## **Binance Charity supports families facing famine across the Horn of Africa with its Giving Tuesday campaign**

**For Giving Tuesday, Binance Charity has kicked off the season of giving by raising funds to support families and children in the Horn of Africa through UNICEF. The crypto community's donations will be matched up to \$100K equivalent in BUSD.**

The crypto community will be able to donate to the campaign via Binance Charity, which will match funding up to \$100,000 USD. The fundraising campaign has launched on the 29<sup>th</sup> November and will run until Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> December. All proceeds will go towards easing the suffering of children and their families living in Somalia, Kenya and Ethiopia in the Horn of Africa, which are all facing crippling drought and starvation, worsened by the impact of the war in Ukraine.

Helen Hai, Head of Binance Charity, "The devastating impact of the war on Ukraine has spread much further than the borders of Europe, resulting in a domino effect of devastation. Many of us are feeling the strain of increased fuel and food prices, but for those in the most vulnerable regions of the world, the implications are catastrophic. Somalia is on the brink of a nationwide famine, as well as other countries across the Horn of Africa being pushed to desperation with crops failing, livestock dying and lives and livelihoods hanging in the balance. That's why we're rallying the crypto community this Giving Tuesday."

Faced with prolonged drought and rising food prices, related to the war in Ukraine, 36 million people in the Horn of Africa are suffering, with 21 million people highly food insecure. Children and their families in the region have been pushed to the brink as crops fail and livestock die, jeopardizing lives and livelihoods in this climate-induced emergency.

The humanitarian situation in the region is dire. Almost two million children across Ethiopia, Kenya and Somalia require urgent treatment for life-threatening severe acute malnutrition.

Communities have been forced to take extreme measures to survive, with thousands of children and families leaving their homes out of pure desperation in search of water, food, pasture, and treatment for sick children. The situation continues to deteriorate, exacerbating a climate-induced crisis that was already depriving children of the essentials of childhood – enough to eat, safe water, school, health services.

Sandra Visscher, Executive Director of UNICEF Luxembourg explains: "As UNICEF is scaling-up the procurement and positioning of essential lifesaving supplies, building on its longstanding presence in the region and working with partners to expand critical services, we welcome any support we can get to avert the worst hunger crisis of our generation."

100% of funds raised will go to support UNICEF's life changing work to help provide children and their families access to safe water, nutritional support including ready to use therapeutic food to treat malnutrition, and access to primary health care.
